- The abstract should be submitted to the portal, to review the paper for keynote session
- Speaker should be Professor, Director, Chairman, Doctor, or any eminent
- The speaker should be present at the conference.
- The speaker should have affiliation from University, Research Center or high Organization

SPEAKER AWARDS

Speakers in the academic conference will have less affiliation comparatively with Keynote speaker. They will be beginners or learners in the field of Medicinal Chemistry. The speech of the Speakers slot will be at the end of the session and they will be learning new ideas from the conference

Eligibility criteria

- The abstract should be submitted to the portal, to review the paper for the keynote session
- Speaker should be Professor, Asst. Professor, and Technical Person.
- The speaker should be present at the conference.
- The speaker should have affiliation from University, Research Center or any academic Organization
